'Nevertheless' is the long awaited third album from Peter Pratt and perfectly matches Peter's crooning vocals to timeless classics and brilliant originals.

- ▶ Peter Pratt will launch 'Nevertheless' at the Gympie Music Muster on Saturday 25th August 2007.
- ▶ Peter Pratt has crafted a benchmark album, with producer, Roger Corbett at The Valley Studio. Every song holds its place perfectly with some of Australia's finest country and jazz musicians.
- ▶ Peter's first single is Letty Catts 1945 classic 'Never Never' and recalls those times in the mid 20th century when we'd go to the Saturday afternoon, jaffa rolling, back row snuggling, matinee at the local cinema. The second single 'Sons Of The Snowy' captures the iconic character of Australian Snowy Mountain cattlemen.
- ▶ From the first track to the last it's vintage Peter Pratt, who has become one of Australia's most distinctive vocal stylists. In truth, there is no one in any field of country music who sounds like Peter. He has the youth and looks of an old fashioned matinee idol coupled with that 'melting butter' voice that creates an instant reaction from every listener.
- ▶ There are surprises on this album as well as songs you'd expect to hear. The title track, Guy Lombardo's "*Nevertheless*" it is sure to stir up nostalgic memories. 'Mary Kathleen' is a hilarious duet with 'Double Decker Dave' about two knockabout country boys competing for the same girl. Cyndi Lauper's 'I Drove all Night' says the kind of words every woman wants to hear from her lover, 'Plasma Cowboy' is a tongue-in-cheek poke at digital movie making and 'Willoughby' is a fine tribute to rodeo champ, Tom Willoughby, both written by Roger Corbett and Peter Pratt.
- ▶ '*Nevertheless*' is the third offering from this Golden Guitar nominee. '*Rope Around My Heart*' and '*Ever True*' scored Peter four consecutive radio hits, two top ten hits and a swag of award and finalist nominations.
- ▶ Peter Pratt is a very special talent on the Australian Country Music landscape. He has lived the life he sings about. A young farmer from country NSW, a former drover, a ringer, rouseabout, wool classer and rider with the Australian Heritage Light Horse Troop.

It's rare and refreshing to discover such genuine and unique talent that is definitely here to stay.
